What is required is an integrated public transport system, efficient and a pleasent experience for the public it serves. Designed to make it a no brainer to get people out of cars and enjoying their commute to school, work, shopping and recreation. This requires use of the virtually unused rail corridoors with Urban & part regional rail, with connecting buses at stations and bicycles carried for free along with free Wifi. For a long time we've had huge subsidies of our roading system but none for rail and precious little for buses. This has led to rush-hour gridlock, which is only going to worsen. Motorways really only bring more cars and trucks into a city with major pressures on parking space. Funding could be 1 to 3% of the fuel at the pump.

This would help Ecan in its quest for reduction of emissions. Transport is responsible for \sim 40%; agriculture 50%. We need a 50 to 100 year plan to reign in climate change and the despoiling of our planet
