We do not support Options 1, 2 or 3.

We suggest that ECAN approach the government to increase ECAN's funding through the Gold Card scheme and allow Gold Card users unrestricted use of the buses. The aging population is increasing and keeping this age group off the road reduces private vehicle traffic.

We also recommend the updating of the bus fleet to buses fit for purpose size-wise and to be air conditioned.

We recommend when tendering for bus routes the tenderers provide demonstrable driver training and driver public relations programmes which should be auditable by ECAN. Many of the drivers we have experienced have been rude, and lack the ability or will to drive the buses safely or comfortably. They also have little appreciation of passenger comfort in relation to heating, cooling or ventilating the buses.

Address those issues and patronage will increase.
