We use it to get to doctors and important appointments and even spontaneous fun days to the mall as I do not drive. This bus gives me back my independence.

I am able to catch this bus with my blind friend, avoid the chaos of the bus exchange (since we both ave disabilities it is better for us to avoid town) and go directly to Barrington or Eastgste. Riding it nearly the entire route a lot of people get on and off along the way. Being able to spontaneously go to the mall with my kids gives me back some of my independence. My son enjoys riding the bus, especially the smaller ones!

The orbiter is not a feaseble option for many of us! It would be an extra hour walk to a bus that takes longer to get anywhere on an overcrowded, poorly seated bus with a pram. With a sick child I could never get to appointments on time and then back in time for school pick-up! I would never be able to ride a bus again making me catch taxis to appointments. All you have succeeded in doing is less bus commuters!

Taking these buses away is a horrible idea. Just looking at money does not show how many people actually ride these buses. I know not to catch this bus before and after school times as the bus is way too full for me and the pram.
