Please allow clean air approved log burners to be installed in homes which do not currently have an existing log burner. Burning wood cleanly is carbon neutral, electricity generation in this country is at least 30% fossil fuel generated so if people are using electric heating a considerable proportion of this is going to be fossil fuel powered.

Please legislate that farmers must plant vegetables around fields containing livestock to soak up any runoff from manure.
