#### Comments.

Request that the funding for Plans, Consenting and Compliance (under Regional Leadership) is sufficient to adequately monitor and enforce resource consents granted by Environment Canterbury. At a public meeting earlier this year regarding the proposed Templeton Quarry by Fulton Hogan the Environment Canterbury officer present admitted that the Regional Council did not have sufficient capacity to adequately monitor resource consent conditions. If the Regional Council is going to issue consents that potentially have adverse environmental effects and adverse effects on affected parties, there is a responsibility that the conditions of these consents (that are intended to mitigate such adverse effects) are adequately monitored and enforced.
