Removing all six bus routes leaving communities with no public transport alternative is no acceptable, especially as some, such as the 145 route, are used by school children to commute to school and would find it harder to get to school after these routes are cut. Planners should relook at those routes and redraw the routes or join them with other routes to keep these communities covered with public transport options. At least if the 145 could be kept around school hours that would be helpful for my local area. Where possible, services should be increased in frequency as low frequency services attract

few patrons. I would prefer a small increase in rates to the cutting of these routes. The public transport system in Christchurch is pretty poor and requires rethinking of routes to take account of the rebuild.
