The other problem that I have with this proposal is that I live about a 5 minute walk away from the 108 and 107 bus stop so stopping those bus routes also makes it difficult for those families living in the same neighbourhood as I do. Last thing, this isn't a problem for me but it's that what about the school pupils living in Northwood that can't get dropped off at school by their parents, there closest bus would have to be the Blue Line on Main North Road, but those buses are always so packed in the mornings.
