## **Bus Routes**

Styx Mill - Northlands 107

Casebrook - Northlands 108

In the Long Term Plan these routes are proposed to be discontinued.

## Proposal.

ECan consider a single new route which connects Northlands Mall, Northwood Mall and Bishopdale Village.

Also connecting Retirement Villages, Schools and other significant people places where possible.

This could be a circular route rather than return route.

A circular route would enable people to travel to

- 1 Connect to other metro services at Northlands or other stops.
- 2 Cover enough of the area to collect people
- 3 Connect significant but different shopping and business centres

Requirement would be two small buses moving around the route in opposite directions.
