Disagree with the removal of 6 routes. Suggest combining the 135 and 150 in order to serve the 4000 approx homes and Alpine View retirement home in the Prestons/Prestons Park development which would lose all services if these routes are removed. Another option to remove the Prestons/Spencerville section only of 150 or have a workers service in/out once a day with the rest terminating at Prestons. Having just spent \$700k on a new house in Prestons Park partly because of a bus service I will be most upset if 150 is removed. Another option would be to extend 135 to operate to include Prestons etc. Ecan need to be aware that some people choose to live on bus routes and if these get altered it can be quite disturbing to the residents, having been through this exercise before with Ecan.

Please consider the re-routing of these services rather than the outright cancellation (which I guess is the easy option for Ecan) but not for those who the buses are meant to serve.
