CANTERBURY REGIONAL PEST MANAGEMENT PLAN – COMMENCEMENT

The Canterbury Regional Council (Environment Canterbury) has made the Canterbury Regional Pest Management Plan (the Plan) in accordance with the Biosecurity Act 1993 s 77(1). The Plan will commence on 1 July 2018.

The Plan is a key component for Environment Canterbury's wider biosecurity programme and provides the regulatory requirements for priority pests across the region.
