The proposed changes will result in a drain at the property being covered by the proposed Bylaw.

As a result the paddocks alongside the drain will not be able to be worked.

I anticipate that more water will pass through the drainage systems and ECan will need to replace the flapped culvert at the end of Mangels drain.

Access to the culvert is via bridge and in my opinion the current bridge would not be able to sustain the weight of equipment including diggers to undertake the work.

ECan would need to maintain the drain yearly.

There is a well at the beginning of the drain and it is important that ECan do not interfere with that as I use the well water for stock.

I have been maintaining the drain but note that a few years ago ECan did enter onto the property and cleared around that drain.

I would not oppose variation to the Bylaw if there was a written memorandum of understanding entered into between ECan and the Trustees that obligated ECan to maintain the drain on an annual basis, preserve the stock water well and to replace the flapped culvert at Mangels drain.
