Purpose

1. To revoke the appointment of a Hearing Commissioner to hear and decide resource consent application CRC182795 to be held by ERP Group Limited.

Recommendations

That the Regulation Hearing Committee:

 Revokes the appointment of Kenneth Lawn as a Hearings Commissioner to hear and decide resource consent application CRC182795 to be held by ERP Group Limited

Background

- 2. Mr Lawn was appointed on 21 June 2018 to hear the resource consent application CRC182795 to be held by ERP Group Limited.
- 3. ERP Group Limited had applied to discharge dust and odour to air at a waste transfer station at 25 Spencerville Road, Christchurch.
- 4. The hearing of the application was delayed as the applicant undertook discussions with submitters who wished to be heard.
- 5. The submitters have now withdrawn their right to be heard, leaving no submitters to be hear on the application.
- 6. The decision on the application can be made by the Regulation Hearing Committee.
- 7. It is recommended the appointment be revoked.

Purpose

Background

- Mr van Voorthuysen was appointed on 23 August 2018 as a Hearings Commissioner, and member of the Hearing Panel to hear resource consent application CRC190445 to be held by Christchurch City Council.
- The application is for the comprehensive stormwater network discharge consent. The hearing is to commence in early November 2018 before a four person Hearing Panel.
- 4. Mr van Voorthuysen has advised that he is no longer available to be a panel member due to a timetabling issue.
- 5. It is recommended the appointment be revoked.

Purpose

1. To appoint a Hearing Commissioner and panel member to hear and decide resource consent application CRC190445 to be held by Christchurch City Council.

Recommendations

That the Regulation Hearing Committee in regard to resource consent application CRC190445 to be held by Christchurch City Council:

- 1. Appoints Hugh Leersnyder as a Hearings Commissioner, and member of the Hearing Panel under s34A of the Resource Management Act 1991; and
- 2. Delegates to Hugh Leersnyder pursuant to s34A(1) Resource Management Act 1991, the function, powers and duties required to: deal with any preliminary matters; hear; and decide the resource consent application

Background

- 2. A vacancy has occurred in the Hearing Panel to hear and decide resource consent application CRC190445 to be held by Christchurch City Council.
- 3. Christchurch City Council has applied for a comprehensive stormwater network discharge consent, that is to discharge water and contaminants to land and water from the existing and future reticulated stormwater network within Christchurch City and the settlements of Bank Peninsula.
- 4. A panel of four hearing commissioners was appointed on 23 August 2018 to hear the application because of the complexity and technical aspect of the application. There are also 30 submitters to be heard. The hearing commences the beginning of November 2018.
- It is proposed an appointment be made to continue with a hearing panel of four members.
- 6. There is no other change to the other members of the panel.

7. Hugh Leersnyder has satisfied Council staff he has the necessary criteria, including technical ability, RMA Accreditation certification, availability and timeframe commitments to carry out the duties required as a Hearing Panel member.
