this time. This Plan will play a key part in the earthquake-related management of land and water

resources.

c) No earthquake remediation, no mitigation of effects of growth and development in the upper Styx catchment on the Lower Styx catchment, no area pland, no capital works in the Long term Plan – and yet the receiving environment are bearing the economic loss, community well-being degradation, loss of values, health and wellbeing neglected in the Lower Styx catchment communities

d) Economic power in the receiving environment Lower Styx Catchment is eroded away by regulation and neglect
the systematic flooding of of properties takes away the means by which individuals can shield themselves from risk , hazard and economic viability .
