Location: Pound Road, approx 50 metres either side of the entrance to Pound Quarry. Weather conditions: Clear blue sky, well lit by natural daylight/sun conditions. No wind. Extremely clear with excellent visibility in all directions. Whilst driving along Pound Road, from the direction of Templeton, I was recording on dashcam the conditions. There was no dust or visibility issues at all along either Waterloo Road, or the Templeton end of Pound Road. Visibility was clear for hundreds of metres. As I continued on this direction of travel I could see that visibility ahead became reduced by what appeared to be dust in the air. As I approached I could see clearly that this was concentrated in the area of Pound Road outside the quarry, for a distance of approx 50 metres in each direction. I parked up close to where the dust was and took numerous photographs, whilst keeping the car running so I could continue filming and adding documentary as evidence. Once I had filmed and photographed for approximately 10 minutes I continued along Pound Road towards the roundabout with Buchanans Road. As I cleared the entrance to the quarry visibility again increased to the extent it was perfectly clear. When I got home I took a photograph of the area I live to show you exactly how good the visibility and weather conditions are. This supports the fact there was DEFINITELY DUST and the related contaminants in the air. And that the dust emanated from the Pound Road Quarry. I noticed as I drove by the quarry entrance there were truck tyre marks on the road surface in the form of compressed dust. There was NO indication that any truck had driven through any water spray to remove dust from the body of the truck or tyres. All the trucks that pulled out of the quarry appeared to be dry. I will assume from this that either a) the dust is from where it was dispersed by wind on a different day. (Unlikely due to the persistent rain we have had for 3 days up until today). or b) this has been brought out from the boundaries of the quarry on the trucks as they leave, due to not being watered down to prevent this from happening. I noticed each time a large vehicle drove by, it picked up the dust from the road where some had settled, and caused it to be visible in the air. Each passing vehicle driving through would be dispersing it further in the air stream created by the vehicle movement. I am aware of the dangers of crystalline silica in this dust. I am also aware that the smaller particles are NOT visible and have a high likelihood of being dispersed over considerable distances. Therefore this dust is a hazard to health. I had to make sure that the airflow in my car was set to 'circulate' so as to prevent any from being pulled into the car which in itself would be unpleasant. I ask that this be followed up as a matter of urgency. I ask that I be contacted by the investigating officer within the 2 days with the reference number. I also ask that I be informed as to what action is being taken against Fulton Hogan for allowing this dust to be dispersed outside of their quarry boundaries. I am aware there have been issues reported in the past, so I am assuming there will be robust action being taken over and above filing NFA, or a warning. This is not the first time this has happened. These are a series of photographs taken Saturday morning with this truck coming off the shingle part of Kerrs Road. The driver of this truck had the courtesy to stop and was travelling at a reasonable speed on this occasion, however it shows the level of pollution raised so you can imagine how horrific this is when the trucks travel at speed (which most of them do)both to and from the quarry and every 1/2 hour on some days. The driver indicated that this was the quickest route to travel and considering the huge road user tax he paid then this was the most economical scenario for his Company. I have to say that he took the pollution aspect for us on board and we did not see him again which has not been the usual response from Ellesmere Transport. He also indicated that he had not been given any instruction or otherwise from Road Metals Quarry regarding the use of Kerrs Road for Quarry business which is disappointing. We have had Fulton Hogan travelling the road this morning and at speed. I have spoken to Fulton Hogan and they are looking into it. I have now had a very quick & positive response from Fulton Hogan and has assured me that he has isolated the problem and there will be no further movement from his trucks on Kerrs Road, he has also said should it happen again we are to contact him immediately. The ironic thing in all this is that the Council have to frequently repair the potholes at the Two Chain road end of Kerrs road and carry out "general maintenance" on the shingle part - presumably to make it smoother for the trucks ?? If the money is available for these kind of activities then surely the very least we could ask for is a "slow" sign to mark the shingle area or a small amount of sealing (say 2-300 mtrs) into the shingle part and not be told to "just diesel it, Ecan will overlook this !! In closing I feel as though I am doing Road Metals, Selwyn Councils & Ecan's job in taking on the trucking companies and with a little persuasion and explanation mostly the Companies involve respond positively.	1
