These images were taken on the 19.06.2014. Local landowner explained that Rooneys were extracting large boulders to use as erosion control for Meridian. To access the Quarry which I understand is located on Braemar station they had to get their machine along Braemar rd. As I understand it they got the machines in without any problems but on the way out decided to drive them through the river rather than use the adjacent Bridge. I observed the attached damage on the upper Mary Burn and was told that the machines also drove through the Irishmans Creek and Forks Stream. I think we need to investigate this incident in which a significant amount of sediment will have entered the streams.	1
