- See a stominator (a device that removes metal from roof runoff) trial in action
- Hear from Christchurch Airport about how they manage stormwater.

Stormwater runs off the land into our gutters and flows untreated into our waterways. Along the way it picks up contaminants that end up in our rivers and streams.
