# **Background**

- 2. Mr B L and Mrs N M Burrows have objected to the decision to refuse the consent.
- 3. Mr and Mrs Burrows applied for resource consent to take and use groundwater, and the surrender of a resource consent in essence transferring the consent to a new site.
- 4. The application is located in the Hook Groundwater Allocation Zone. The zone is overallocated as based on Plan Change 3 of the Land and Water Plan.

- 4. The application was publicly notified, and five submissions were received, Four submitters wish to be heard and all oppose the application.
- 5. The applicant has requested a pre-hearing meeting. The purpose of a pre-hearing meeting is to clarify a matter or issue; or facilitate a resolution of the matter or issue.
