I appreciate the good work ECan is doing across Canterbury but I'm rather concerned about the proposed Representation for the 2019 election and I must object to it if the power of a vote in Central Christchurch is 40% less than a vote in South Canterbury.

Fair representation is a critical pillar of democracy, guaranteed by the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990 and the Local Electoral Act 2001.
