

Harbourmaster's Approval, issued pursuant to:
Canterbury Regional Council Navigation Safety Bylaw 2016
clause 20(2)(a)(ii).

Name of approved groups: French Farm Aquatic Club	
Period: From: 10th October 2016 until the Bylaw is superseded by a review; or Until revoked by the Harbourmaster.	
Area to which Approval applies: All the waters of the Canterbury Region.	
Purpose: To approve the existing vessel identification systems of the named sporting bodies as being compliant with the requirements of clause 20 of the Bylaw in order to avoid having more than one form of vessel identification displayed on these vessels.	
Approval: The vessel identification systems of the named groups are approved by the Harbourmaster as being compliant with the vessel identification requirements of clause 20 of the Bylaw.	
Conditions: Vessel identifications with lettering/numbering less than 90mm high issued by the named groups to their members prior to this Approval may remain until such time as they require replacement. Any replacement vessel identification or new issues of vessel identifications shall have lettering/numbering having a minimum height of 90mm.
