Note: The Orange line, 125 and 100 buses all take you to Halswell.

Did you know..?

Using a Metrocard you can make as many bus trips as you like in a single day for only \$2.80 (i.e. 2x child's fare).

Metrocard gives you unlimited free transfers within two hours of your first trip. If you travel after the two hour period is up you'll be charged another single fare. It costs \$1.40 - \$3.30 child's fare one way depending on which zones you travel through.
