1. My full name is Graham James Harrington.
2. My qualifications and experience are as set out in my evidence in chief dated 15 October 2018.
3. I again confirm that I have read and agree to comply with the Code of Conduct for expert witnesses contained in the Environment Court Practice Note (dated 1 December 2014). I confirm that the issues addressed in the statement of evidence are within my area of expertise. I have not knowingly omitted to consider facts or information that might alter or detract from the opinions expressed.
4. On 1 March 2019 I provided a draft supplementary brief of evidence for the Christchurch City Council (**Council**). In that draft brief of evidence I outlined my further analyse of modelling information about the effect of extreme weed growth in the Styx channel and addressed several other matters in response to other evidence. I suggested that the water quantity experts again caucus and seek to produce a joint statement addressing that new information.
5. By Minutes dated 4th and 14th March 2019 the Commissioners directed that a joint statement and my finalised supplementary evidence be lodged by 15 March 2019.
6. The water quantity experts have engaged again in expert witness conferencing. They have produced a second joint statement dated 15 March 2019. That joint statement is lodged with this brief of evidence. The joint statement addresses all of the topics that were to be in my supplementary evidence. I therefore do not repeat them here.
