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**FURTHER MINUTE OF COMMISSIONERS ADDRESSING PROVISION OF  
FURTHER MAP AND FURTHER REPLY TO MATTERS ARISING FROM  
RECONVENED HEARING OF 15 APRIL 2019**

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- 1 In accordance with our earlier directions, the hearing was reconvened on 15 April 2019 for the purposes of questioning of the water quantity experts.
- 2 During the questioning, there were discussions regarding stormwater quantity effects in the Lower Styx catchment in a 1 in 10 rainfall event scenario.
- 3 To assist us in our decision making, we request that the applicant provide a map, in the same or similar form to those attached to the second Joint Witness Statement, showing the flood depth across the Lower Styx catchment in a 1 in 10-year rainfall event at the calibrated weed scenario. If possible, the map should show the depths at existing development and at maximum probable development.
- 4 We understood that such a map is not difficult to produce, and that the information is readily available.
- 5 We record that Mr Pizzey was unavailable to attend the reconvened hearing. To ensure that this matter continues to progress, we direct that any further response from Mr Pizzey, restricted to the matters arising from the reconvened hearing, together with the requested map, be provided no later than Friday 26 April 2019.
