# 4.1. Hearing of submissions to the Annual Plan 2019-2020

#### **Purpose**

1. To update Councillors about the hearing of submissions/feedback to the Draft Annual Plan 2019-2020, and to provide Councillors with guidance about the hearing process.

#### Recommendations

#### That the Council:

- 1. receives the feedback on the Annual Plan 2019-2020 and the submissions on the Revenue and Financing Policy, and Fees and Charges Policy; and
- 2. accepts the late submissions to the Annual Plan 2019-2020, as appended to this report

#### **Background**

2. Engagement on the draft Annual Plan and consultation on the Fees and Charges Policy, and Revenue and Financing Policy was open from 18 February to 19 March 2019. A total of 102 submissions were received with 37 submitters indicating they would like to present their submission to the Council in person.

#### Late submissions

- 3. 4 late submissions were received after 19 March (Please refer to these submissions appended to the report).
- 4. Council is required to resolve to accept the late submissions.

#### The hearing

5. The hearing is the opportunity for submitters to present their submission to Council in person. Each submitter has been allocated 10 minutes for their presentation.

6. Councillors can ask submitters questions of clarification only (through the Chair) but cannot cross examine or debate the submissions. No decisions on the submissions presented at the hearing are made at this meeting.

#### **Conflict of interest**


- 7. A Councillors conflict of interest can arise in either of two general ways:
  - where a Councillor stands to gain a pecuniary benefit from a matter before Council for consideration (whether personally; or through connections with other individuals or businesses with which the Member is involved referred to as "pecuniary interest"); and
  - where a Member holds a bias, or might be perceived to hold a bias, in relation to a matter that is before Council for consideration.

#### **Next steps**

- 8. Following the hearing of submissions, the Council will meet on Thursday 16 May 2019 to deliberate on all the submissions.
- 9. On 20 June 2019 the Council will meet to adopt the Annual Plan 2019-2020 and set the rates for the 2019/2020 financial year.

Not sure if you are the right person, but wonder if you can formally accept a late submission from WDC to the Ecan Annual Plan 2019/20.

Following a joint meeting with Ecan Councillors and WDC Councillors today (9 April 2019), WDC staff and Councillors indicated that an additional \$10,000 has been allocated from WDC to the Ecan Ranger Service for additional presence to enforce the *Northern Pegasus Bay Bylaw 2016*. Each Ecan Councillor present was provided with a copy of the Northern Pegasus Bay Bylaw 2016 Implementation Plan.

The request to the Ecan Annual Plan 2019/20 is that this \$10,000 additional funding from WDC to the Ecan Ranger Service is matched with a concomitant amount from Ecan's budget.
