Notification of material proposed to be incorporated by reference into the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan

The Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan sets out the resource management outcomes for land and freshwater resources in Canterbury, and a framework to deliver on those outcomes.

The Council is in the process of developing proposed Plan Change 7 to the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan (Proposed Plan Change 7). It is anticipated that the plan change will be notified for public submissions in mid-2019. The plan change will amend provisions (e.g. policies and rules) that apply throughout Canterbury, and include a new framework to deliver the community's freshwater aspirations for freshwater within the Waimakariri and Orari-Temuka-Opihi-Pareora sub-regions.

In accordance with s34(2) of Part 3 of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act (1991), the Council invites comments on its proposal to incorporate the following material into the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan:

- **Canterbury Regional Code of Practice for Defences Against Water and Drainage Schemes (April 2019); and**
- **Canterbury Regional Pest Management Plan (2018 – 2038)**

The documents listed above are updated versions of material currently incorporated, by reference, into the operative Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan. Proposed Plan Change 7 will replace all references to earlier versions of these documents with the updated references listed above.
