I oppose the application by Fulton Hogan for the following reasons: _____

I attend the Samadhi Vihara regularly to pray and to meditate in a serene environment. the proposed site of the quarry is only 140m across the road (Maddisons Road) from the boundary of the temple,

The quarry will be in operation from 6am to 6pm daily, including Saturdays. On 150days of the year, they are proposing to work for up to 24h. _____

Incessant loud noise from the operation of machinery at the quarry will make it difficult to carry out our normal activities. Also, noise from heavy trucks carrying aggregates from the quarry will add to the noise levels. For 150days they plan to have some night time activities which will also have an impact on the health and well-being of the resident monks. _____

Increased dust nuisance, from crushing, stockpiling of aggregates until required. Also from trucks as they drive down roads. _____

Potential health hazards caused by dust on all who are exposed, but would be more harmful to children and the elderly. _____

Effect on water quantity and quality. _____

I want the authorities to DECLINE the application from Fulton Hogan and NOT GRANT consent for a quarry on the site bounded by Dawsons, Curragh, Maddisons and Johns Road. _____

I would like the following conditions imposed if consent is given: _____

Hours of operation: Quarry to work only on weekdays Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm. Quarry should NOT be operating or doing any other work during the weekends and public holidays. Our religious programmes and meditation programmes are usually scheduled for the weekends.

Truck Movements: Reduce truck movements to and from the quarry to 1000 per day. Truck operations to cease between 6pm and 7am in the weekdays. No truck movements to be allowed in the weekends. Trucks should be covered to prevent dispersal of dust while in transit. _____

We want the quarry to stop operating heavy machinery when we hold Meditation retreats

There should be NO Heavy vehicles travelling on Maddisons Road to or from the quarry at any time. _____
