Reasons comment:

Air pollution and the amount of debris that comes off Fulton Hogan trucks when they are driving. Traffic management, especially on Kirk Road and the very narrow Railway Terrace/Jones Road bend and the Railway Terrace/Kirk Road intersection. These roads are not built to withstand the volume and weight of the Fulton Hogan trucks coming to and from proposed Royden Quarry.
