I oppose the application from Fulton Hogan to establish a quarry for the following reasons:											
Noise: Fulton Hogan hopes to operate the quarry from 6 am to 6pm each day, including weekends. Noise from the continuous operation of machinery at the quarry during these times will make it difficult to carry out religious practices including meditation. Meditation requires a serene, quiet environment without noise or disturbances. Several programmes take place in the evenings or during the weekends with many people in attendance. All special events are also held at the Samadhi Vihara at the weekends. So having the quarry operating in the evenings or during weekends will have huge negative impact on our community											
Dust: Dust can have severe health effects on the elderly and children. Poor air quality is known to be a trigger for asthma sufferers. Depending on the wind speed and direction, we can have the temple buildings and meditation huts covered with dust and grit, requiring extra cleaning which could be costly.
