2.	The reasons for making my submission are: (state in summary the nature of your submission, giving reasons)			
	I oppose the application by Fulton Hogan for the following reasons:			
	Noise Levels: The quarry will be in operation from 6am to 6pm from Monday to Saturdays. In addition, on 150 days, they will increase the operating time to 24h per day. Continuous loud noise emanating daily from the quarry will make it difficult for us to carry out our usual religious activities at the temple such as offering prayers, participating in religious discussions, listening to talks, meditating etc Further, noise from heavy trucks travelling on Maddisons Roads carrying aggregates from the quarry will add to the noise levels. Night time operations will disturb the sleep of the resident monks at the Samadhi Vihara and may even affect their health and wellbeing.			
	Location: Fulton Hogan is proposing to build a quarry very close to residents, established businesses, schools and farms. The quarry will only be 140m from the Buddhist temple, Samadhi Vihara, where I regularly go to pray and to meditate in a screne environment. The location and surroundings of the Samadhi Vihara is conducive to carrying out Buddhist religious activities and Meditation practices at present. Having a quarry operating daily will disrupt this screnity and the peaceful nature of the surroundings making it difficult to carry out our activities.			
	Water: Ground water levels and quality may be affected. Increased use of water for aggregate washing, dust suppuration, truck washing, staff use etc. will impact on the availability of water in the Selwyn district.

3.	I wish the consent authority to make the following decision: (give details, including the general nature of any conditions sought)			
	I want the authorities to DECLINE the application from Fulton Hogan and NOT GRANT consent for a quarry on the site bounded by Dawsons, Curragh, Maddisons and Johns Road.			
	I would like the following conditions imposed if consent is given:			
	Reduced the hours of operation and allow Fulton Hogan to carry out work at the quarry only on weekdays Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm. The Quarry should NOT be operating or doing any other work during the weekends and public holidays. This will allow us to continue with our religious programmes and meditation programmes without interruption.			
	Reduce truck movements to and from the quarry to 1000 per day. Truck operations to cease between 6pm and 7am in the weekdays. No truck movements to be allowed in the weekends, public holidays or night time. Trucks should be covered to prevent dispersal of dust while in transit. There should be NO Heavy vehicles travelling on Maddisons Road to or from the quarry at any time			
	We also want the quarry to stop operating when we hold Meditation retreats at the Samadhi Vihara, so that those who attend an have the full benefit of meditating in a peaceful and quiet environment. We plan to hold about 4 Meditation retreats annually, each retreat will be of 1 -2weeks duration
