am a Sri Lankan Buddhist who attends the Samadhi Vihara, 358 Maddisons Road in, Rolleston regularly. I oppose ne application from Fulton Hogan to establish a quarry for the following reasons:		
Noise: Noise from the continuous operation of processing machinery at the quarry will make it difficult for me to carry out religious practices including meditation. Meditation requires a serene, quiet environment without noise or disturbances. Noise from heavy trucks going to and from the quarry will add to the noise levels		
Dust: Dust from the quarry will be a nuisance and will effect amenity, visibility and impact on structures. Dust will be a problem during site preparations, even before the quarry operations start. The direction and speed will affect how much and where the dust pollutes. Fulton Hogan must install water sprayers to mitigate the effects of dust		
Increased traffic in the area from trucks, site workers and visitors will clog up the narrow roads.

I want the Selwyn District Council and ECAN to DECLINE the application from Fulton Hogan and NOT GRANT conse for a quarry on the site bounded by Dawsons, Curragh, Maddisons and Johns Road.		
ould like the following conditions imposed if consent is given:		
Hours of operation: Allow Quarry to work only on weekdays Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm. Quarry should not be operating after 6pm weekdays or during Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays. This is because religious programmand meditation programmes at Samadhi Vihara are usually scheduled for the evenings and weekends and quarry operations will make it very difficult for us to carry out our normal activities at the temple.		
Truck Movements: Reduce truck movements to and from the quarry to 1000 per day. Truck operations to cease betw 6pm and 7am in the weekdays. No truck movements to be allowed in the weekends. Trucks should be sprayed with water and covered to prevent dispersal of dust while in transit.		
Fulton Hogan must ensure that there are no truck movements on Maddisons Road at any time
