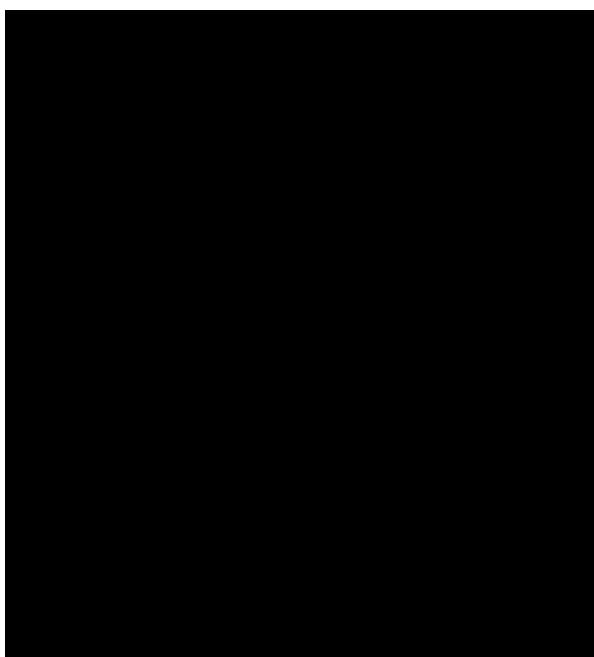

Reasons comment:

I am opposing the application in its entirety and is asking that the application as a whole be declined. I am a 19 year old student that has been living in Templeton with my parents for almost 11 years. I want to school in Templeton and have spent many hours walking and running on the roads around Templeton. I love living in Templeton. It is part of Christchurch City but does not feel like City life. It has a much more rural feel to it. I often see farm animals on Kirk Road as I drive into town. My reasons for making this submission is because of the significant adverse effects the proposed quarry will have not only on us living in Templeton, but even more so on the residents closer to the proposed site. Because of the nature, size and duration of the activities the effects will be more than minor and can't be completely mitigated. I would like the application to be denied because of the more than minor effects the following activities will have on the environment and the people living in it: 1. Dust * Health Effects * Nuisance dust * Visibility * Effects on Plants 2. Traffic & Transport Infrastructure I am a young driver and have very serious concerns about the safety of the roads around Templeton but also travelling into the city. I was looking forward to the reduction of 2,000 heavy vehicles that NZTA showed as one of their benefits of spending \$195 million. The other benefits of a safer road and faster travel times would have made a huge improvement. Should this application be approved it will undo all the good NZTA was trying to achieve and the only ones who will benefit will be the applicant. We have to take all the risk with no reward. I often drive down Jones Road to go and visit my grandparents in Rolleston. I am very concerned about the impact the heavy vehicles will have on these regular trips.
