I oppose the application by Fulton Hogan for the following reasons: _____

Location: Fulton Hogan is proposing to build a quarry very close to residents, established businesses, schools and farms. The quarry will only be 140m from the Buddhist temple, Samadhi Vihara, where I regularly go to pray and to meditate in a serene environment. The location and surroundings of the Samadhi Vihara is conducive to carrying out Buddhist religious activities and Meditation practices at present. Having a quarry operating daily will disrupt this serenity and the peaceful nature of the surroundings making it difficult to carry out our activities.

Noise Levels: The quarry will be in operation from 6am to 6pm daily, including Saturdays. On 150 days of the year, it will be operational for up to 24h. Incessant loud noise from the excavation work and operation of machinery at the quarry will make it difficult for us to carry out our normal activities. Also, noise from heavy trucks carrying aggregates from the quarry will add to the noise levels experienced by those attending the temple. Night time operations will affect the health and wellbeing of the resident monks at the temple because of sleep disturbances. _____

Increased dust nuisance, from crushing, stockpiling of aggregates until required and from trucks as they drive down roads will lead to potential health problems, especially in and the elderly. _____

Effect on water quantity and quality resulting from aggregate washing and dust suppression. _____


I would like the following conditions imposed if consent is given: _____

Reduced hours of operation: Quarry to work only on weekdays Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm. Quarry should NOT be operating or doing any other work during the weekends and public holidays. Our religious programmes and meditation programmes are usually scheduled for the weekends.

Reduce truck movements to and from the quarry to 1000 per day. Truck operations to cease between 6pm and 7am in the weekdays. No truck movements to be allowed in the weekends, public holidays or night time. Trucks should be covered to prevent dispersal of dust while in transit. There should be NO Heavy vehicles travelling on Maddisons Road to or from the quarry at any time

We plan to hold about 4 Meditation retreats annually, each retreat will be 1 -2weeks duration. We want the quarry to stop operating when we hold Meditation retreats, so that those who attend an have the full benefit of meditating in a peaceful and quiet environment
