- Location - Too close to residential area including schools & pre-schools.
- Traffic - Excessive use of rural roads by heavy vehicles
- Roadding - Rural roads are not fit for purpose, too narrow, unsafe
- Pollution - Dust, noise, machinery emissions, extra traffic
- Safety - Rural roads in this area have an extra high rate of accidents already. Extra volume will increase accidents.
- Future use of land - unable to be used for housing or recreation, also a scar on landscape from the air as the majority of visitors arrive by air over this area.
- Health - silica dust is extremely toxic, affecting air and water quality.
- Underground Aquifers. - Water quality will be effected.
- Increased Water use - To damp down dust, our water is too good for this use.

Property values will drop if this proposal goes ahead.
Property use will be effected, gardeners, horse trainers, farmers.
Mental Health, Stress and anxiety will increase for locals.
