I attend the Samadhi Vihara situated at 358 Maddisons Road regularly to participate in religious practices and to attend the meditation classes. I oppose the application from Fulton Hogan to establish a quarry for the following reasons: _____

Noise: Fulton Hogan plans to have the quarry in operation from 6 am to 6pm each day, including weekends. Noise from fixed and mobile processing plants at the quarry during these times will make it difficult for the devotees to carry out religious practices. Noise from the quarry will have a negative impact on those who want to meditate as Meditation requires a serene, quiet environment without noise or disturbances.

Dust: Depending on the wind speed and direction, we can have the temple buildings and meditation huts covered with dust and grit, requiring extra cleaning which could be costly. Cumulative effects of increased dust, noise on the health and wellbeing of the resident monks and devotees, especially the elderly and the children, is of concern _____

Water: The quarry would use water for washing aggregates and also for washing trucks. This may have an effect on water quantity and quality if allowed to soak into the ground. _____

The establishment of a quarry so close to the temple will result in the loss of a peaceful, serene environment necessary and conducive to our religious practices _____

I would like the following conditions imposed if consent is given: _____


Reduce the Hours of operation: Quarry to operate only on weekdays Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm. Quarry should not be operating during the weekends or evenings after 6pm as religious programmes and meditation programmes are usually scheduled for the weekends and evenings. If noise levels exceed the agreed levels, then the quarry operation must stop

Truck Movements: Reduce truck movements to and from the quarry to 1000 per day. Truck operations to cease between 6pm and 7am in the weekdays. No truck movements to be allowed in the weekend to or from the quarry. _____

Monitor wind speeds and stop operations if over the agreed levels _____
