RE APPLICANT: FULTON HOGAN LIMITED

- CRC192408 Land use to excavate material
- CRC182409 Land use to deposit cleanfill

I support the application.

I do not wish to be heard in support of my submission.

The reasons for making my submission are:

1. Someone needs to develop new quarries to ensure an ongoing supply of quality aggregate to the construction industry in order to maintain the current infrastructure in and around Christchurch, and support the continued growth of the area.
2. This site is preferable for two reasons;
 - a. Its relatively close proximity to Christchurch city. This reduces the transport costs associated with getting the aggregates to where they are needed. In turn this reduces the financial burden of infrastructure maintenance and development that falls indirectly on the entire community in the form of housing prices and rates costs to name two.
 - b. It is adjacent to the soon to be opened Christchurch Southern Motorway and SH1 meaning trucks carting into an out of the quarry can access routes that are designed for heavy vehicles, without using the local rural or urban roads.
3. A review of the information Fulton Hogan has placed on their web site regarding their proposal and application shows they have put considerable effort into laying out and operating this quarry in such a manner as to cause as little nuisance to the surrounding community as possible. I believe they will carry through with this intention as their current quarrying operations present as professional operations run by a socially responsible organization.
