We object to all the Resource Consent Applications from Fulton Hogan for a Quarry bounded by Carraghs, Dowsons, Madisons & Jones Roads. We have lived in this area for 32yrs were well aware of Air Traffic, Ruapuna, Railway & Quarries to the west when we settled here. We placed great value on the farmland to the South and consider forming the appropriate use of this soil a groundwater. The effects of increased traffic, noise, dust, and general disturbance to the environment will greatly impact on the life of our community. The amenity value of Templeton will be severely affected.

The proposed truck movements will totally overwhelm the local roads making private travel more difficult. Noise from these plus the quarry activity will constantly affect the lives of residents.

Dust through many months of the year will be significantly above normal. This will be difficult & costly to control possibly wasting precious ground water. Quarring should be kept to the areas Northwest of Templeton along the river.


