

**Reasons comment:**

The proposed Roydon Quarry is a concern to the community in several ways. 1) Traffic - since the expansion of Izone the traffic around Weedons especially along Maddisons & Jones Rd and surrounding cross streets has seen a notable increase. This quarry if approved would add to the traffic on these roads. It's far quicker to head north via Dawsons or Curraghs Rd than use the State Highway as Fulton Hogan have tried to make out. 2) Air Quality - trips passed current Fulton Hogan Quarries at Pound Road and West Coast Road at Yaldhurst show evidence of dust in the air well outside the boundary of the Quarry. There is no reason to think that this wont be the case here too. 3) Water - With a large lifestyle block community surrounding the area any possible contamination to the ground water is a concern to well being of the health of the community. 4) Noise - The Fulton Hogan proposal states that they wish to use this quarry 24 hours a day 7 weeks a week for a large part of the year. There are properties surrounding the area on all sides, and a large community at Templeton close to it's Northern Boundary. 5) Changes to set back laws - Any approval of this quarry prior to proposed new Governmental setback laws could put residents in danger.
