I oppose this quarry going ahead because we have lived in Templeton for approximately 36 years and having come from the country have always found that Templeton is a lovely quiet peaceful village and the change in the future if the quarry went ahead would make our village a busy noisy village instead. My second concern is the health of us all. Having worked as a Practice Nurse at our local doctors Medical Centre for 20 years until recently I am sure the dust would affect those with breathing issues, causing a cumulative effect. These people already suffer greatly on a daily basis - how will they be with a quarry in our backyard? Also the health of our animals they too will be affected. Are they going to spray water on the boundaries 24/7. What will this do to our water levels? I am also greatly concerned with the increase in traffic volume. 1 truck = 6 cars, 1 truck + trailer = 12 cars, how will the road cope, plus the busy traffic now.

I strongly oppose the quarry in Templeton going ahead but request these conditions:

- How will you control the truckies using covers on all trucks. Will it be monitored 24/7.
- How can you ensure the dust control.
- Will the landscape be improved, and be a visual improvement.
- The monitoring equipment must be the best not the cheapest and we the public must have access to this.
- How can you ensure the safety of us on Jones Road, Waterloo Rd, and Kirk Road? If a Round-about is put in at Dawsons Rd what about the backup of traffic when the flow is interrupted with a truck and trailer, and several more trying to get around and then over the Railway Line.
