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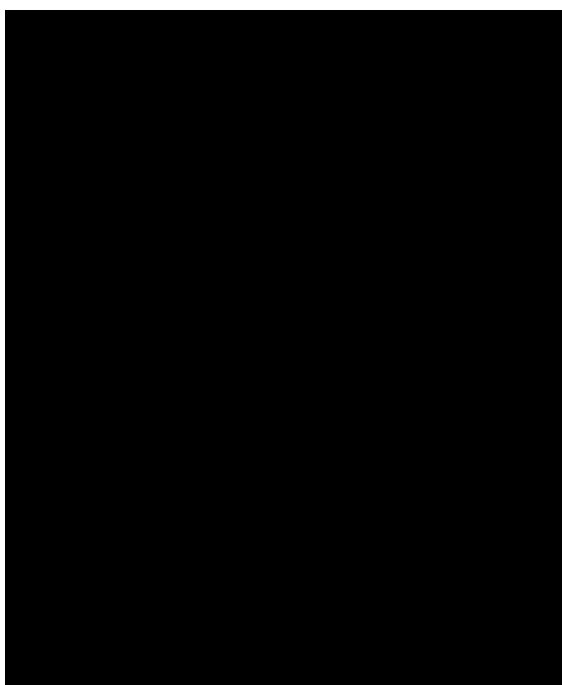

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**Reasons comment:**

- It perpetuates the belief that quarries can be located in close proximity to neighbours without the requirement for a setback of at least 250metres from all boundaries of the applicants land. - The hours of operation are unreasonable. - The adverse effects of dust. - The adverse effects of noise. - The adverse effects on amenity including but not limited to dust, visual and truck generation - The area of land to be excavated before rehabilitation occurs is excessive. - The social impact - The lack of a specific quality rehabilitation plan and end use. - The continuation of processing after excavation is finished. - No reference to whether aggregate will be imported and processed on site. - The adverse effect on water.

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**Consent comment:**

- To decline the application. - If consent is granted it should be conditional on the full rehabilitation of their existing quarries. In other words cleaning up their mess. - If consent is granted it should set the bar in terms of best practice and give back to the community in regard to ecology and recreation.
