2. The reasons for making my submission are: *(state in summary the nature of your submission, giving reasons)*

- Traffic dangers caused by trucks and construction vehicles:

There is a **45k/h speed limit** on the curve linking **Jones Rd and Railway Terrace**, it has very limited eyesight. Several **traffic accidents** had occurred before. The frequent appearance of dumping trucks and construction vehicles will cause substantial amount of traffic dangers for Templeton residents, especially those who live along Jones Road and Railway Terrace.

On Kirk Road there are more than 300 pupils at **Templeton Primary School**, dozens of preschoolers at **Templeton Preschool & Nursery and Kids First Kindergarten** nearby, the busy passing dumping trucks and construction vehicles will put children in great danger.

- Noise pollution caused by trucks and construction vehicles:

Templeton residents live by Jones Rd and Railway Terrace will be affected by the appearance of dumping trucks and construction vehicles too. As the width between residential boundary and road is less than **2 meters**. Noise pollution will be significant.

- Negative impact on strategic long term development of southwest Christchurch:


Selwyn District Council and Christchurch City Council have put great efforts in developing modern **business parks, cycling tracks and Sports/Community Centre**. The areas alongside southern SH1 are shaping into a prosperous and versatile region that is friendly to both businesses and communities. It will be very short sighted to allow a polluting quarry to operate among the middle, as it will not only impose serious traffic dangers, but also various air and noise pollution to the nearby facilities. The Roydon Quarry should not be considered in the blueprint of future Templeton.
