



## AMENDMENT TO THE CANTERBURY REGIONAL POLICY STATEMENT

### PUBLIC NOTICE

The Canterbury Regional Council (**Environment Canterbury**) gives public notice that, in accordance with sections 55(2) and 55(2A) of the Resource Management Act 1991 (**RMA**), minimum targets for sufficient, feasible development capacity for housing in Greater Christchurch for the period 2018-2048 have been inserted into the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement (**CRPS**), as required by the National Policy Statement on Urban Development Capacity 2016 (**NPS-UDC**).

A new Objective 6.2.1a, inserted into Chapter 6 of the Canterbury Regional Policy Statement, sets out minimum housing targets for the Greater Christchurch area over the medium (next 10 years) and long term (10 to 30 years). The insertion of these targets is a requirement of Policies PC5-6 and PC8 of the NPS-UDC. The targets refer to the number of dwellings to be enabled, rather than the amount of housing that is built in any given period.
