Our objections relate to the proposed installation of fish ladders that would only allow native fish to pass unobstructed in specific waterways. The installation of such devices would halt the movement of Salmonids - Rainbow trout and Brown trout.</p> <p>Our club believes that this would have a serious impact on our world renowned trout fishery. Further any such impact on the fishery would dramatically reduce the pleasure gained from fishing in the outdoors which is enjoyed so much by all of our 87 members.</p>	<p>The Canterbury Fly fishing Club wish to have Environment Canterbury construct any required fish ladders/bypasses that would allow both native fish and Salmonids to pass.</p> <p>We further acknowledge that there may be a very small number of waterways where for scientific reasons these streams may be protected for native fish. We would expect that these streams would represent less than 5% of all total Canterbury waterways.</p>
