1	Rule 5.140 Temporary structures Condition 5	Oppose	The proposed additional permitted activity condition 5 is considered unnecessary as proposed conditions 3 and 4 appear to seek the same objectives as condition 5. Noting these provisions provide for temporary activities, NZDF considers that existing conditions 1 and 2 and proposed conditions 3, 4 and 6 sufficiently manage the potential effects of the activity.	Delete proposed additional condition 5.
2	Rule 5.141 Temporary discharges Condition 3	Oppose	The existing provision is considered appropriate for temporary discharges, as the duration of the discharge is limited both within 24 hours, and over a month. Given the specific attributes of temporary activities (and associated discharges) these existing provisions are appropriate and imposing specific total suspended solids limits (which would require monitoring to confirm the limits are met and the activity is in fact permitted) is considered excessive in relation to these activities.	Retain the operative version condition 3 of Rule 5.141.
