Submission

The provisions do not allow for a recreational/ amenity allocation from the Eyre Groundwater Zone, ie just like community water supplies and mahinga kai allocation. Specifically in the Kaiapoi North Regeneration area where Regeneration projects, offering community recreational amenity, may be excluded from existing, transfer of existing water takes and/or non-consumptive new/future water takes.

Provision

8.4.16

Avoid the grant of any water permit for the take and use of surface water or stream depleting groundwater until the freshwater outcomes in Tables 8(a) and 8(b) are met for that surface waterbody, except where:

- the take will replace an existing lawfully established take affected by the provisions of section 124 - 124C of the RMA; or**
- the take and use is for a community water supply, enhancement of mahinga kai, environmental enhancement (including managed aquifer recharge or targeted stream augmentation), or the take is non-consumptive.**
