Given that Canterbury's groundwater is the region's largest freshwater environment with substantial biodiversity and important ecosystems, it is a serious omission not to include a table or discussion of freshwater outcomes for groundwater.</p> <p>The proposed Managed Aquifer Recharge projects have the potential to adversely affect endemic aquifer species, therefore the following new point h. should be added to the Plan. <i>Adverse effects on the biodiversity and ecosystem functioning within the recharged aquifer from potentially invasive (exotic and indigenous) species are eliminated.</i></p> <p>The Plan will be strengthened and clarified if all the submission points, terms and definitions submitted by Mr Fenwick are included in the Plan.</p>	Allow
