Reasons comment:

Dairy farming in New Zealand has escalated to unsustainable numbers of cattle, with corresponding alarming levels of greenhouse gas emissions. This proposal to discharge

wastewater into our oceans already overloaded with our carbon emissions and plastic waste, is yet another assault on our environment. It facilitates and supports the dairy industry which has and continues to cause unprecedented damage to our local and national environment, including the fertiliser use, nitrogen intensification and cattle urine and faeces destroying our waterways, and the detrimental effects of this on human health and our biodiversity (e.g. threatening native fish) will be felt for generations and hundreds of years to come. Dairy farming is not a sustainable future activity with the challenges our population now must face with unprecedented levels of polluted waterways, oceans, and dangerously escalating global warming. This proposal by Oceania Dairy Ltd aims to facilitate expansion of it's business, and asks for a long timeframe on the consent, with conditions allowing it to increase the wastewater outfall in years to come. It allows Oceania Dairy to continue with producing large amounts of greenhouse gas emissions in both the production of dairy products and the dehydration processes, for exportation, and as such is not in the interests of New Zealanders, who stand to be directly affected by the adverse effects of climate change associated with greenhouse gas emissions.
