Reasons comment:

MGI operates the irrigation infrastructure in the area. Babbage Consultants have consulted with MGI regarding the applications. 1) We support the discharge to the coastal marine

area because the discharge onto land is not sustainable during winter months and during rainfall. The land discharge is highly visible and it impacts on MGI because stakeholders think the irrigation company is irrigating, when in fact it is Oceania Dairy. The coastal alternative is the preferred option and the farms involved still have a supply of MGI water to irrigate land with. 2) The proposed pipeline down the Archibald Road reserve will affect MGI infrastructure but any adverse effects can be managed. During winter 2020 MGI is constructing a new water pipeline down Archibald Road on farmers land, but it will cross Archibald Road in three locations. Oceania Dairy say that they will use trenchless construction methods to work around the existing pipelines (it will need to pass underneath the MGI infrastructure). MGI has suggested that Oceania lay a conduit pipeline underneath the MGI pipes while they are being constructed. This small precommitment would ensure that there is no adverse effect on the MGI pipes when Oceania construct theirs.

Consent comment:

Grant the consents sought, subject to appropriate conditions. Condition on CRC201187 for the pipeline earthworks to ensure that construction around existing water pipelines under Archibald Road is performed to avoid adverse effects on water pipeline operation (in summer) and construction standards. There shall be no disruption to the embedment and compaction standards around the existing water pipelines.
