- Other agencies and interested parties work programme to follow

- Strengthened protection for wetlands, streams and indigenous ecosystems including fish passage
- Announcements mid 2020

Review of 3 Waters and Water Services Regulator

- 1 August 2019 regulatory framework released
- 25 October 2019 stand alone Crown entity to regulate drinking water
- December 2019 Water Services Regulator Bill introduced
- Mid 2020 National Environment Standards for Sources of Human Drinking Water and Wastewater Discharges and Overflows released



Resource Management Framework review

- November 2019 Issues and Options paper
- February 2010 feedback due
- Panel considering feedback
- Mid 2020 Panel report to Minister for Environment with recommendations



Resource Management Act Amendment

Late March 2020 - Report back to the House



New Zealand Biodiversity Strategy

- August 2019 consultation started
- 22 September 2019 submission due
- Mid 2020 advice considered by Cabinet



National Policy Statement on Indigenous Biodiversity

- November 2019 consultation started
- 14 March 2020 submission due
