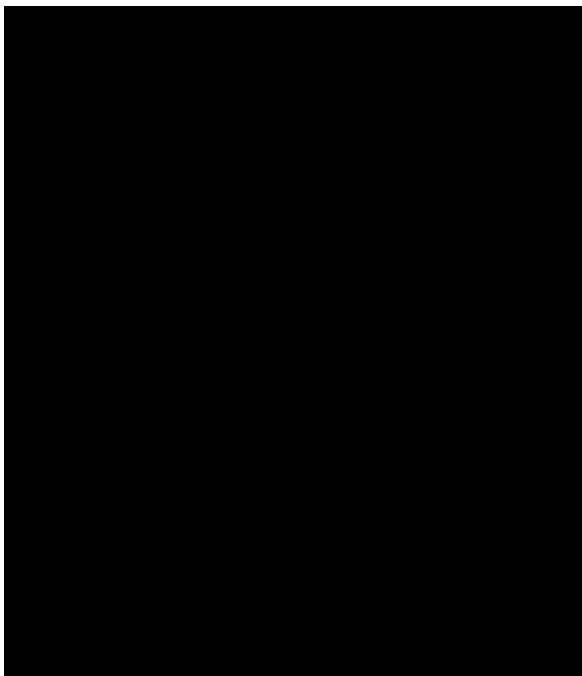

Reasons comment:

Over the 30 years we have lived here ,Tegal has operated on Carmen Rd and we have been forced to endure the factories pollutants in our environment. At times the smell is so bad you cannot go outside or even open your windows .I have noticed over the years Tegal may be carrying out activities of discharging pollutants during the night which I'm sure has reduced the number of complaints ,not the volume of activity around discharging contaminants. As I like to sleep with the window open, this has at times caused great distress having been woken during the night by the dreadful smell and at times thick and almost chemical in nature coming in to the house,and in more recent years the incessant

alarms which go off during the night ,which I have tried to contact Tegal about with no success and also have called noise control about. I have also complained on occasions around the fact that fatty deposits accumulate on my vehicle which is parked outside ,after a pollutant discharge .Surely this waste in the atmosphere and on personal property is completely unacceptable and unhealthy. I believe the factory began as a smaller operation in a somewhat rural area ,however the area has changed in demographics ,which clearly has not been a consideration for Tegal as it has hugely expanded its operations over the years. I question whether such an operation on this scale would be allowable in this area if it were planned as a new venture, we therefore believe an abattoir placed in a suburban area is totally unacceptable and totally oppose its continuation!

Consent comment:

We would wish that the factory cease operations on Carmen Rd and seek a more appropriate location for the culling and processing of animals.
