2. The reasons for making my submission are:

- Canterbury is long overdue for a modern waste processing and stabilization facility that has the capacity to efficiently and properly manage the anticipated future volumes of hazardous materials being disposed.
- The proposed facility is well located within an appropriately zoned area and close to main transport routes
- The majority of the odorous processes are to be undertaken within an enclosed building which will contain odours prior to being passed into a biofilter.
- The use of a biofilter is a widely adopted and efficient manner of treatment for odorous air. A biofilter in conjunction with a robust monitoring and management programme, is the best approach to dealing with odour from processing of this nature.
- The operations at the existing Bromley site and the existing biofilter there have a good track record in respect of managing offensive odours.
- The application and supporting information confirm that the levels of discharge to air can be managed so as to be negligible
- We are confident that, based on the information provided, a suite of conditions can be imposed that will result in any potential effects of the onsite operations remaining no more/than minor
