Reserved Areas: Lake Benmore from 2km approximately east of Sailors Cutting to Lake Benmore Dam, 150 metres out from the Lake shore.

Purpose: Rock Blasting on shore for Alps to Ocean Cycle Trail	
Reservation: No vessel shall navigate within the Reserved Area as listed during times of Rock Blasting where it is likely that Lake Users will be endangered by falling debri except with the express permission of, and in a manner explicitly approved by, the certificate holder or his delegate.	
Conditions: Publication of notice of Reservation: Notification to known affected groups; including but not restricted to Local Boating, Kayak and Canoe clubs, all camping grounds along the shores of Lake Benmore, notifications on appropriate websites and social media; notices at known boat ramps and key access points. Publication in the Christchurch Star and Christchurch Press, Timaru Herald, Twizel Update at least one week prior to the blasting occurring. Regular updates to the above on days and times of blasting to be continued during project on social media.	
Notice of Reservation to be: Displayed at: All boat ramps on Lake Benmore. Displayed by: Hamish Seaton or authorised representative. Removed by: Hamish Seaton or authorised representative	
A copy of the Temporary Reservation Certificate to be carried by: Hamish Seaton or authorised representative	
Safety Conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><i>The shot firer will ensure that no lake (or land) users are within range of the blast or falling debri. Blast guards (spotters) will be put in place as required. 3 short soundings of a loud air horn will be given 2 minutes prior to detonation. 1 long sounding will be given immediately prior to detonation. 2 medium length soundings will be given once all is clear.</i><i>It is advised that a safety boat is on the water at blasting times to ensure complete safety of on water vessels or persons. This condition is at the discretion of the contractor.</i>	
Temporary Reservation shall not take effect if: Conditions above are not met.
